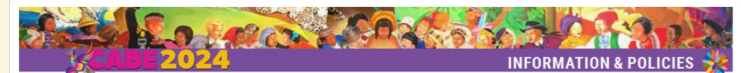
CABE 2024 Conference Registration Badges

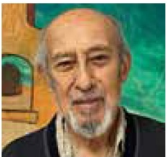
